

OUR PURPOSE

Families with individuals who have disabilities face a range of unique challenges. These challenges include limited social opportunities, societal prejudice, a lack of understanding, and difficulties navigating everyday activities. Unfortunately, individuals with disabilities are often overlooked and neglected in our community and nation. The term "individuals with disabilities" encompasses a wide range of diagnoses, from mild to profound, including developmental delays, medical conditions, psychiatric conditions, physical disabilities, mental limitations, and congenital conditions.

At Aid Another, we recognize and embrace the diversity within the population of individuals with disabilities. Our primary goal is to meet them where they are and provide opportunities for inclusion and acceptance. We achieve this by advocating for their rights and promoting awareness within the community. To enrich the lives of children with disabilities, Aid Another has developed several programs that offer a safe, supportive, and structured environment. These programs include art, dance, music, educational assistance, recreational activities, and sports.

Aid Another is committed to supporting individuals with disabilities and their families. We are dedicated to ensuring the ongoing success of individuals with special needs by providing valuable vocational and educational training to help them achieve professional accomplishments. We strive to create a more inclusive and accepting society by providing various programs and services that cater to their unique needs.



AID ANOTHER GIVE ME FEELING OF Normalcy, inclusivity, and Equality, provides social Experiences In 2023, Aid Another focused on building for long-term sustainability. We brought in <u>The Social</u> <u>Impact Firm</u> to support our operations and development. We performed audits on the programs, budgets, and teams. Based on the findings, Aid Another has made an incredible impact on individuals with disabilities in the greater Virginia Beach community through programs, events, and relationships. Through participant surveys and interviews, there is an overwhelming consensus of gratitude for Aid Another.

We spent the year preparing policies and processes, launched our donor campaign, created a development committee, created processes for financial reporting, and built up our programs.

Notable:

- We launched adaptive cheer, which was a huge hit.
- Developed partnership with local Walmarts and received \$5,000 in grant funding with \$20,000 committed for 2024.
- We hosted our first annual Gala and raised \$12,000.
- We have established systems and policies for operations and financial reporting to sustain long-term growth.
- We hosted our first Aid Another camp.
- We hosted our flagship events, the Awareness Hike, which raised \$17,000, the Teamsters Local 822 Golf Tournament, which raised \$24,000, and Pandas Fight Against Cancer, which raised \$15,000 with our valued partners.
- We launched our monthly donor partnerships.
- We grew our partnerships and network base by 20%.

OUR 2024 Strategic plan

Focus on the thriving programs and invest in growth

What:

Aid Another has served the greater Virginia Beach community with programs that fulfill a community need for individuals with disabilities. Our discovery showed that the social club, baseball, cheer, dance, and basketball have been an incredible asset to our participants.

How:

We will add more basketball and cheer sessions by hiring both paid and volunteer coaches. We will add a holiday recital for the dance program. We have hired Cynthia Gossman as the Program Director, overseeing the operations of all programs.

Cultivate community and business partnerships

What:

Partner with businesses to provide growth opportunities for our programs. Outreach and relationship-building teams.

How:

We have developed a strategy and marketing materials to outreach to new partners. We have developed a team to work and connect with valueshared businesses that would like to support Aid Another.

Create several sources of revenue generation

What:

Aid Another has identified serval areas to generate revenue. In order for a nonprofit to be sustainable, revenue-generating activities beyond donations are needed.

How:

We are developing processes to sell merchandise at all of our activities and online. We are in the planning stages of creating resource workshops for the community. We are partnering with local professionals for revenue-sharing services. We are ensuring that our programs are

Maintain and enhance fiscal and operational record-keeping and reporting structure

What: Establish policies and procedures for keeping records of program impact as well as fiscal responsibility: grant strategy, planning, and submission.

How:

We have set up our QuickBooks account to track our finances efficiently. We are establishing a reporting cadence. We are setting up program management budgets and reports. We have identified grants to submit for throughout 2024 that align with where we are as an organization and our mission. We have surveys for our programs and evaluate our feedback.
